Services Provided:

Information & Referral – linking individuals to community providers regarding a variety of social issues which include, but not limited to: employment, community service, health & wellness, legal issues, housing and education.

J.U.S.T.

(Juvenile Ultimatum Service Training)- A service component that provides youth the opportunity to complete mandated community service hours through a balance and restorative justice, community service learning, community protection and competency development process.
