Construction Activities Update—Street Paving Improvements Glendale Avenue Wastewater Capacity and Street Improvement Project

The City's contractor, Excel Paving Company, is currently finalizing preparations for street paving along Glendale Avenue, between San Fernando Road and Broadway.

Pavement rehabilitation timeline:

- **October 27, 2014** – start of pavement grinding on Glendale Avenue and side streets, a 4-5 day process, lane closure and reductions with minor delays to cross traffic
- **November 3, 2014** – base paving via Cold In-Place Recycling on Glendale Avenue, a 4-5 day process, lane closure and reductions with significant delays up to a few hours for cross traffic
- **November 10, 2014** – place leveling pavement on cross streets, intersection closure for a few hours
- **November 12, 2014** – re-compaction of base pavement on Glendale Avenue, a 1-2 day process, lane closure and reductions with minor delays to cross traffic
- **November 13, 2014** – surface paving on Glendale Avenue and cross streets, a 4-5 day process, lane reductions with significant delays up to a few hours for cross traffic.

During each paving phase, you will be directly affected by paving operations for approximately 1 to 2 days.

- **December 2014, January 2015** – work will continue on Glendale Ave-adjustment of utilities, pavement striping installation, traffic signals modification and flashing beacons at pedestrian crossing. The contractor will clean up the work site during the holiday weeks to be presentable.

During this period we request the following:

- Use alternate streets when possible; please observe detour signage
- Leave early if possible – before 7:00 AM from October 27 - November 18
- Allow additional travel time for delays, which may be as long as an hour

You will receive a 3-day door hanger notice from the contractor with the specific dates, locations, and restrictions, when the work is adjacent to your house.
