Conditions:

- 1. Relocate the window on east elevation to be centered with the roof ridge.
- 2. Use wood posts instead of plaster for the proposed covered porch.
- 3. Use nail-in windows instead of Z-bar.

Analysis:

- **Site Planning:** The proposed site plan is minimally affected by the new addition. The additional floor area is being provided as a guest house attached to the existing two-car garage, located at the rear of the lot. The impact created by this proposal is minimal because most of the existing conditions are maintained and the addition provides all Code required setbacks. The proposed site plan fits well with the existing site conditions and within the neighborhood pattern.
- Mass and Scale: The proposed single-story addition to the detached garage is designed to match the existing in terms of mass and scale. The roof forms and rooflines match the existing and are carried throughout for consistency. The plane variations on all elevations and change of material in the front help break up the massing of the structure.
- **Design and Detailing:** The proposed addition matches the existing in colors and materials. The overall design is well crafted and provides consistency throughout the existing garage and the main house. Good quality materials, colors and details are used, while providing a matching design. Window placements are also appropriately chosen.
