Conditions:

- 1. Two ornamental trees should be planted in the front yard to replace the two trees removed for safety concerns.
- 2. The skylights shall be flat rather than domed.

Site Planning – The site planning appears consistent with the majority of homes in the neighborhood and with the Design Guidelines. A consideration to plant two ornamental trees in the front yard to replace two that will be removed for safety concerns is recommended.

Mass and Scale – The proposal's mass and scale is sensitively handled and will be consistent with the existing house and compatible with the low-profile one-story neighborhood homes.

Design and Detailing - The proposed design and detailing is comprised of good quality materials, colors and details and appears internally consistent with the existing Modern-style architecture with a condition that the form of the skylights should be flat rather than domed. As conditioned, the proposal appears to complement the neighborhood and will be consistent with the intent of the Design Guidelines.
