## **Conditions:**

- 1. The windows at the addition should be block frame installation with wood sills and surrounds.
- 2. The windows at the addition should have external muntins to match the existing window pattern and complement the original home.
- 3. The existing wood windows with wooden sills and surrounds at the existing portions of the home shall remain.
- 4. As a consideration, windows at the ground level addition along the western and southern elevation should be raised higher to avoid weathering issues.
- Site Planning: Overall, the location of the addition is appropriate, compatible to the project site, and well-suited
  to the neighborhood context. Since the addition will be located at the rear, the site planning as seen from Santa
  Carlotta Street will not be affected.
- *Mass and Scale:* The mass and scale of the project appear to sufficiently relate well to the surrounding neighborhood. The addition will be located at the rear and at an area of the lot that has a lower grade than the front portions of the existing home. To further reduce bulk appearance along this elevation, staff suggests the applicant should recess the addition a minimum one-foot away from the east property line.
- **Building Design and Details:** Overall, the proposed addition is well-designed and appears to be harmonious with the neighborhood. The proposed detailing and textures appear to be appropriate for the design of the home and the neighborhood. While details for the windows at the addition have not been provided, staff recommends

the windows to have a block frame placement with wood sills and surrounds, and external muntins to match the existing windows.
