South Central Corridor

The South Central Corridor consists of the portion of South Central Avenue between Elk Avenue to the north and Cypress and Magnolia Avenue to the south. South Central Avenue is a major arterial. It is lined with an eclectic mix of retail, commercial and residential uses reflecting a variety of time periods and architectural styles that accommodates frequent public transit with direct access to the Metrolink Station.


