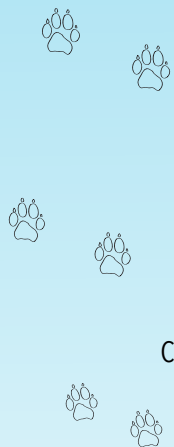

# Discover Coyotes: The Small Wild Dogs

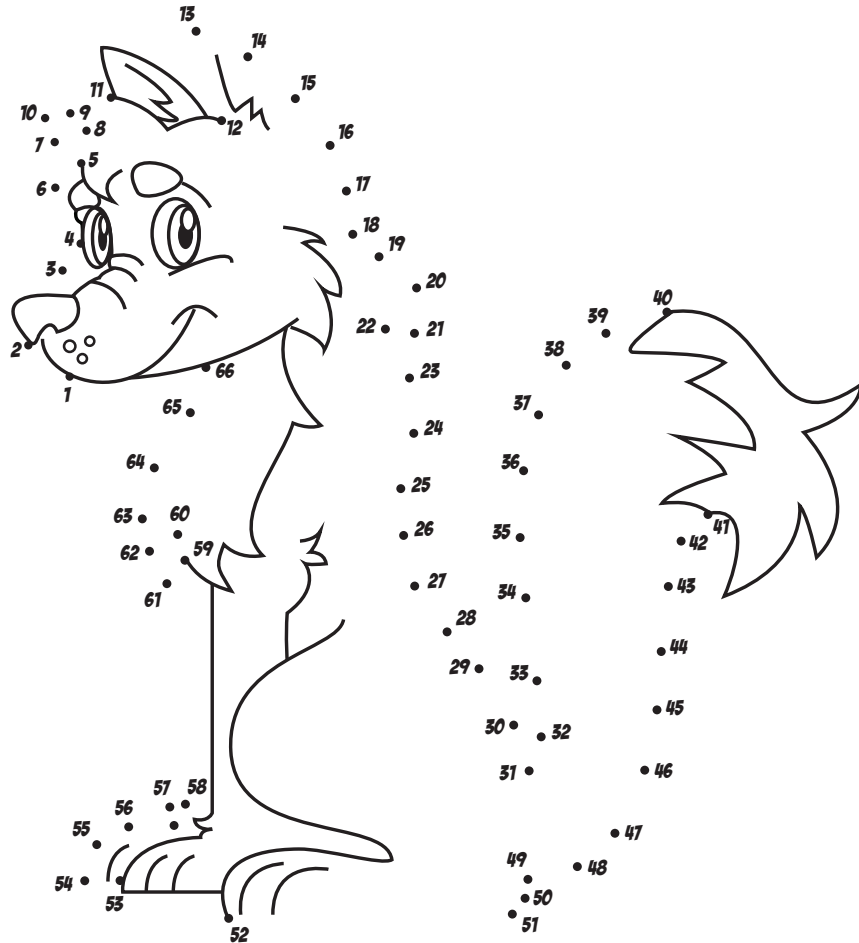

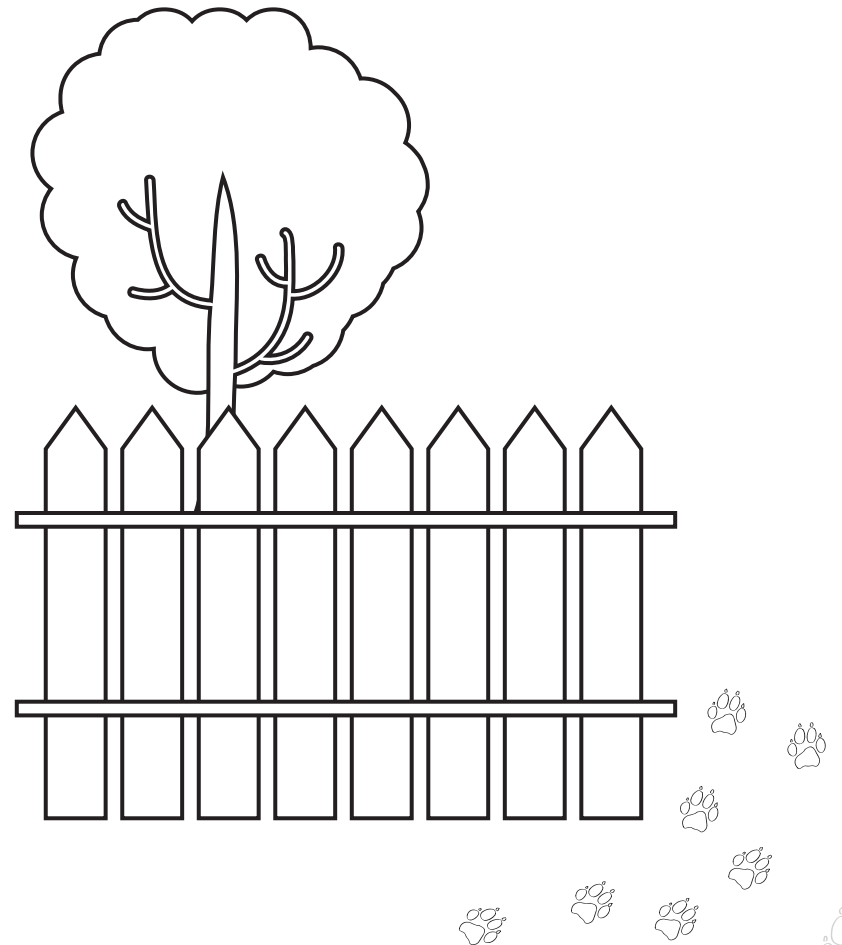

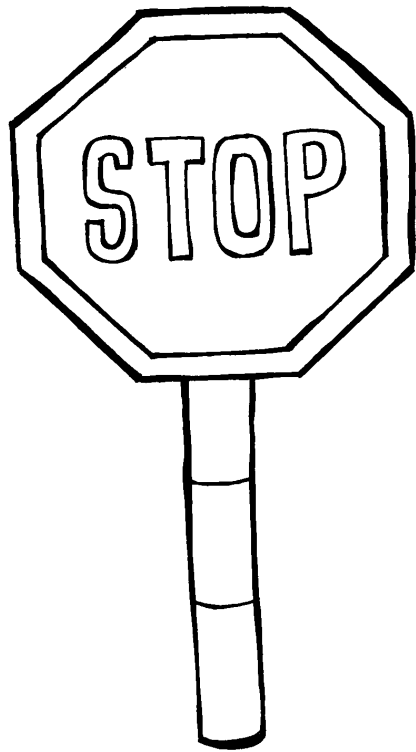
# Connect the Dots

back on them.

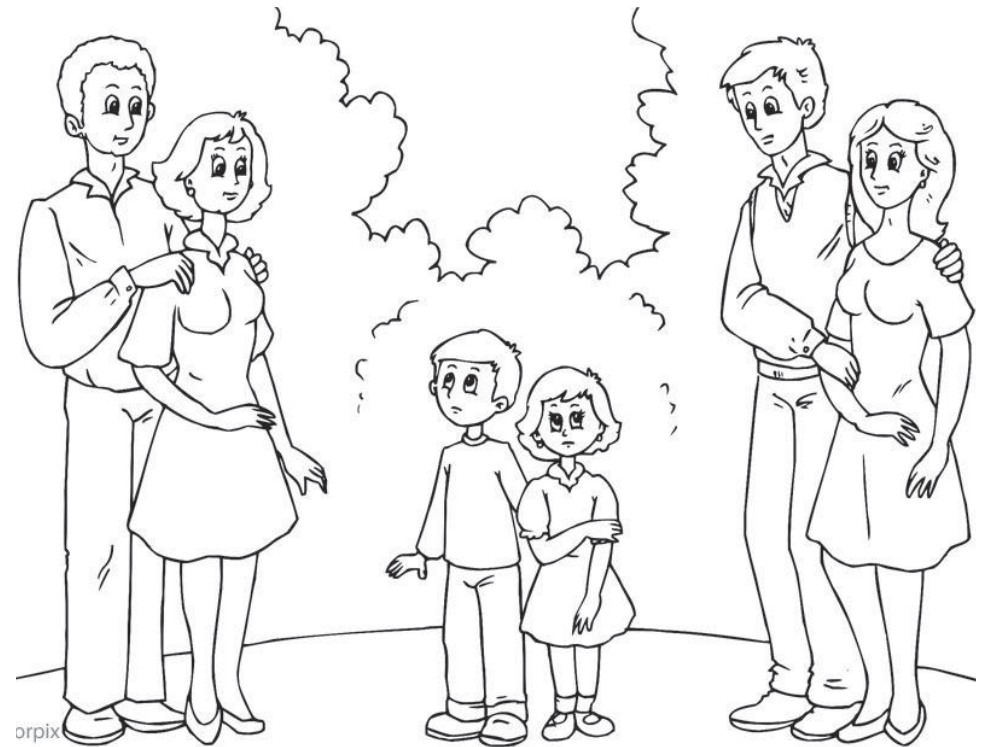

Always tell a parent.

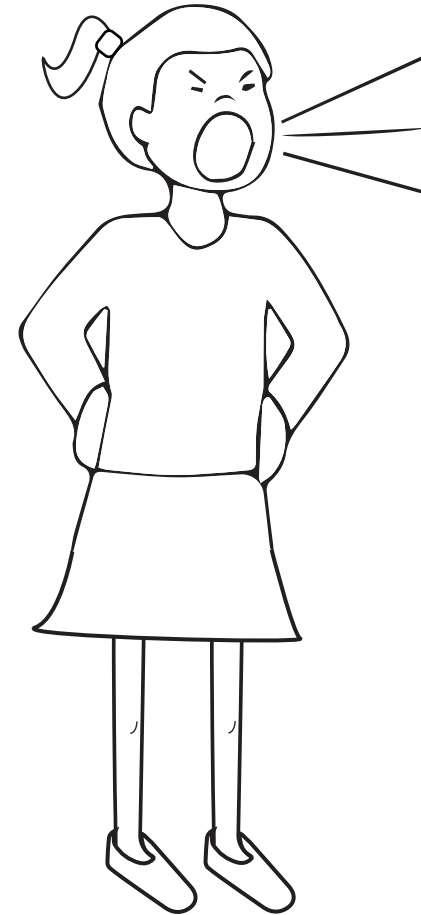
LOOK!
