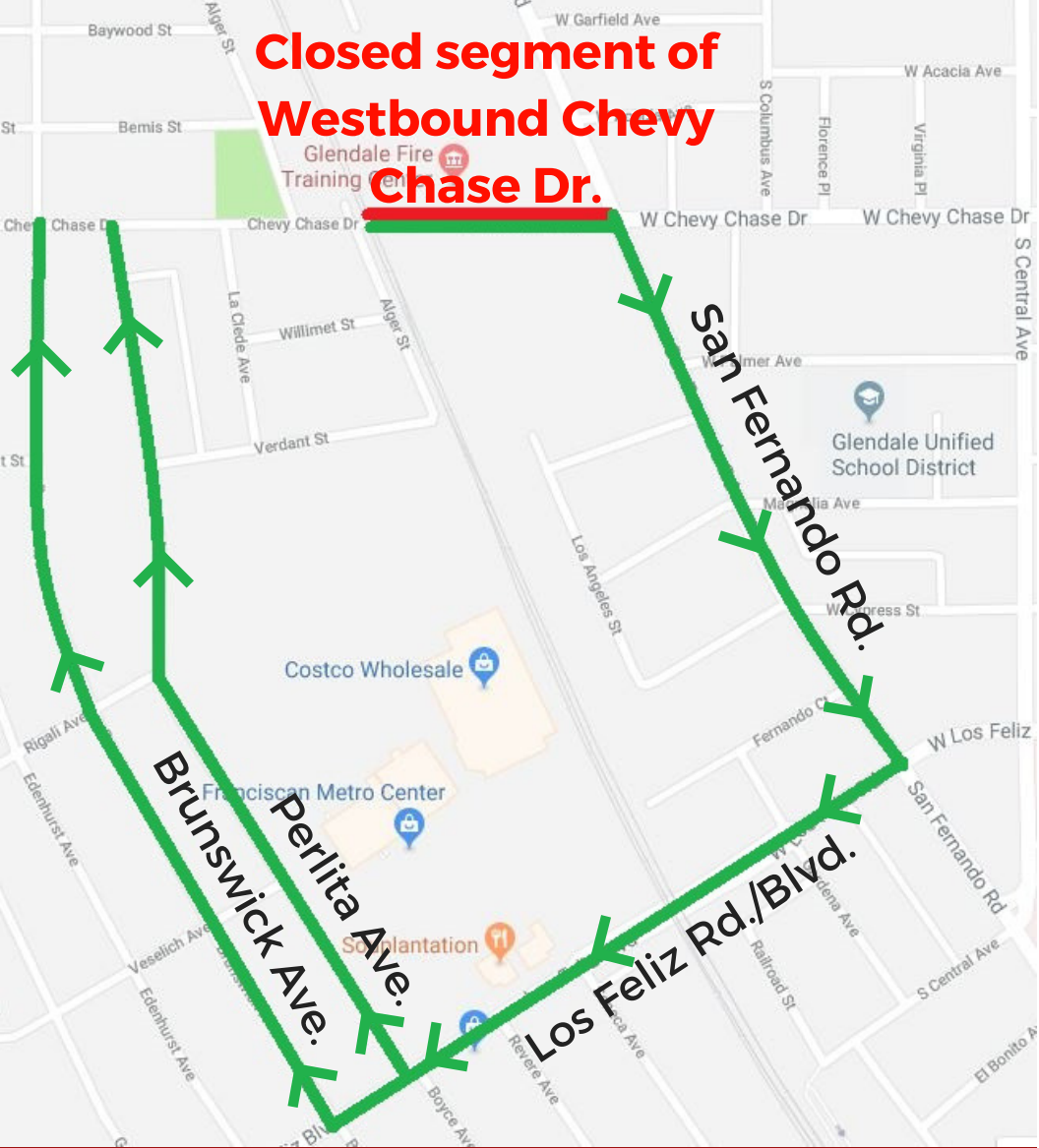

Chevy Chase Sewer Diversion Project: Road Closure Notice





Closed segment of Westbound Chevy Chase Dr.

Traffic Control Plan

Westbound Chevy Chase Drive will be closed between San Fernando Road (in the City of Glendale) and the railroad tracks along the boundary with the City of Los Angeles. The work will last for approximately 3 weeks starting February 20, barring any unforeseen conditions. Automated messaging signs will be posted on San Fernando Road both north and south of Chevy Chase Drive, as well as on Chevy Chase Drive. Traffic traveling westbound on Chevy Chase Drive from Glendale to Los Angeles will be redirected at the intersection of Chevy Chase Drive and San Fernando Road to the detour route (see map at left). Drivers can use San Fernando Road, Los Feliz Road, and either Perilita or Brunswick Avenue to get around the construction area. The City of Glendale thanks you for your patience and cooperation as we work to complete this public improvement project!

- Westbound Chevy Chase Dr. closed from San Fernando Rd. to railroad tracks
- **Eastbound Chevy Chase Dr. will be OPEN at all times**
- Closure expected to begin February 20 and last approximately 3 weeks
