NOTICE OF CROSSWALK REMOVAL CITY OF GLENDALE, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 21950.5, that the City of Glendale has scheduled the removal of the existing crosswalk at Central Avenue and Fairview Avenue. Pursuant to CVC Section 21950.5, an existing crosswalk may not be removed unless notice and opportunity to be heard is provided to the public not less than 30 days prior to the scheduled date of removal. The scheduled date of removal of the existing crosswalk at Central Avenue and Fairview Avenue will not commence prior to April 12, 2018.

The crosswalk will be replaced with a new crosswalk located immediately north of the same intersection. Due to the unique geometry of the Central Avenue/Fairview Avenue intersection, the new crosswalk will be considerably shorter than the one it replaces, thereby reducing the pedestrian crossing distance. The new marked crosswalk will also be supplemented with traffic signs and beacons.

The city will hold a public hearing to receive public input on **Monday, March 12, 2018** at **6:30 p.m.**, at the City of Glendale Municipal Services Building (MSB), **633 E. Broadway, Room 106, Glendale, CA 91206**
