CONTEST RULES

Criteria for Art & Description

Each entry must be composed of a piece of artwork and a description (on the entry form). All must meet the requirements below.

Eligibility

All students in **grades Kindergarten through 12th grade** who are residents of Glendale and enrolled in GUSD, private school or homeschool. *Students must work individually.*

ARTWORK & DESCRIPTION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. One entry per student.
- 2. Artwork must be easily hung on a wall.
- 3. Each entry must be no larger than 1.5' x 2.5'.
- 4. All art mediums are acceptable (e.g., colored pencils, crayons, paint); recycled materials are not required but encouraged. Artwork must be hand-drawn by the student.
- 5. A description of no more than 75 words must accompany the artwork (space provided on the entry form).
- 6. Label each entry on the back in pencil (marker bleeds through the artwork) with student's name, age, grade, school name, parent's telephone number and email address.

Entry Form

One entry per student. Please make sure the entry form is filled out completely and legibly. All entries (form + artwork) must be dropped off at Central Library between October 27-October 30.

Competition Process

A panel of City employees will assess all entries and select up to 6 winners. Entries (artwork and description) will be judged on the creativity, use of recycled materials, and relevancy to the theme. Winners will be announced at the Award Ceremony.
