



## Central Library Grand Re-Opening: Spring 2017

The Central Library renovation is coming into its home stretch, completing major construction elements in time for our Spring 2017 Grand Re-Opening. We "closed the curtain" at the end of the day on September 1, 2016, so that our construction crews can move into high speed until we are ready for our big reveal. We are exploring options for alternative spaces in the downtown area, however the Central Library building will be closed to the public.

Once unveiled a re-imagined Central Library will be a state-of-the-art facility for public access to information and technology. In addition to fresh new spaces for learning, studying, and collaboration, it will include a MakerSpace, a Remembrance Room, a Digital Lab, 6 new conference rooms, a reinvigorated teen space, an upgraded auditorium with a green room/audio mixing room and an adjoining catering kitchen, an updated Children's Room, and more self-service options. A top priority of the Building and Safety Division is to ensure the health, safety, and general welfare of people who work, visit, or reside in the City through the enforcement of regulations which protect property and structures. Because most inspection requests are driven by concerned residents, the City of Glendale's goal is to ensure efficient and timely results by authorizing Building and Safety Inspectors the ability to issue administrative citations.

This alternative method of code enforcement, as opposed to judicial remedies, will allow for timely compliance with code regulations. The issuance of citations imposing administrative penalties will be performed at the discretion of the officials of the city.

Beginning September 1, 2016, Building & Safety Inspections Staff will begin utilizing Administrative Citation procedures to encourage compliance with and remedy violations of Glendale's adopted Codes.


