STONE BARN NATURE CENTER

The Stone Barn was originally built between 1905-1915, by the Le Mesnager family. Throughout the years, it has served as a winery, stables, residence, and now a nature center. It burned down in the 1933 wildfire, but was rebuilt to the structure you see today.



Visit the nature center to learn about the history of the land by the Dunsmoor family, the winery that Georges Le Mesnager and his family ran, and the acquisition of the park by the City of Glendale.
