



ARE YOU IN COMPLIANCE?

NOTICE: The Ordinance regulating Distribution of Disposable Foodware Accessories went into effect on February 11, 2022.

Disposable foodware accessories include:

utensils

condiment packets

disposable straws

stirrers

splash sticks

cocktail sticks

toothpicks

napkins

wet-wipes

cup lids

cup sleeves

beverage trays

Provisions

Starting February 11, 2022 - Large food and beverage facilities:

- May only provide disposable foodware accessories to dine-in and take-out customers upon request.
- Must display the City of Glendale Distribution of Disposable Foodware Accessories Ordinance Customer Advisory Notice (see reverse side).
- May ask drive-through and delivery customers if they want disposable foodware accessories.
- Can provide a cup sleeve and lid to drive-through, take-out, or delivery customers if they order hot beverages.

Starting March 13, 2022 - All food and beverage facilities in the City:

- Must use an online ordering platform with an "opt-in" feature for customers to obtain disposable foodware.
- Cannot provide disposable foodware accessories if they were not requested through the "opt-in" feature.
- Shall not provide self-serve Disposable Foodware Accessories dispensers.

Exemptions:

 All Health Facilities and Residential Care Facilities for the elderly as defined in Sections 1250 and 1569.2 of the California Health and Safety Code are exempt from the provisions above.
