

Best Practices to PROTECT OUR WATERWAYS

Prevent discharges to storm drains and do not expose waste or raw materials to rainwater

Maintaining trash bins

Keep trash bin area clean with lids closed.

Do not fill bins with liquid waste.





Maintaining grease bins

Keep grease bin area clean with lid closed. Do not let grease leak out of the bin or onto the ground.





Cleaning floor mats

Clean floor mats and equipment in a mop sink, wash rack, or floor drain connected to the sanitary sewer.





Disposing of mop water

Pour wash water in a mop sink, wash rack, or floor drain connected to the sanitary sewer.





Cleaning outdoor areas

Clean spills by sweeping, applying cat litter, or spot treating with a mop. Do not let wash-water pool or flow offsite.





Preventing sewer overflows

Maintain grease interceptors, grease traps, and private sewer lines regularly in order to prevent sewer overflows.
