### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Application for an Administrative Use Permit (AUP) to allow the on-site sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages (ABC License Type 47) at an existing restaurant (Salt & Olive) located in the "DSP/GAT" (Downtown Specific Plan/Gateway District) Zone.

#### **CODE REQUIRES**

1) The sale of alcoholic beverages requires an Administrative Use Permit in the DSP/GAT Zone (Section 3.3 of the DSP, Table 3-A-3).

## **APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL**

1) To allow the on-site sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption at an existing full-service restaurant.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION**

The project is exempt from CEQA review as a Class 1 "Existing Facilities" exemption, pursuant to Section 15301(e) of the State CEQA Guidelines because the discretionary permit request is to allow the on-site sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages at an existing restaurant and there is no additional floor area proposed.
