
2024 Glendale Point-In-Time Homeless Count




HOMELESS FOR THE FIRST TIME 24 YES













Race and Ethnicity Demographics Sheltered & Unsheltered





Age Demographics




Gender Demographics











Household Composition



GLENDALE CONTINUUM OF CARE'S FOCUS...

- Through the coordination of the CES, work closely with Ascencia, Home Again LA, LA Family Housing, and Village Family Services to expand resources for homeless individuals, families, youth and other sub-population groups to secure housing and supportive services.
- Continue to work strategically to re-prioritize available funds to reallocate programs that are no longer HUD's priority to maintain it's competitive status and continue to secure renewal and new funding.
