

## **Project Overview**

The Citywide Traffic and Mobility Study will:

- Provide recommendations to maintain traffic flow and circulation while enhancing active modes of travel – such as walking, biking and taking transit – and discouraging traffic intruding into our residential neighborhoods.
- Evaluate lane reconfiguration alternatives identified in the <u>Citywide Pedestrian Plan</u> and <u>Bicycle Transportation Plan</u> and consider emergency response routes, look closely at the possible impacts, and then develop recommendations to keep traffic moving as much as possible.
- Evaluate traffic conditions at signalized intersections, all-way stop-controlled intersections, and roadway segments for current and near-term future conditions.
- Use the Study's analysis, along with community feedback, to help guide Glendale transportation policy and projects for years to come so we have safe and efficient streets that work for everyone.
